

AccessDane Enhanced Services

AccessDane's Public Agency Access System: There is no fee for this access.

AccessDane's Subscription Access System: The subscription fee is **\$50.00** per calendar quarter.

AccessDane's Surveyors Premium Access System: The subscription fee is **\$200.00** per calendar quarter.

What are the differences between AccessDane Systems?

AccessDane information and services content varies between portals based on interest, statutory or mandated requirements, county policy, and technical/system performance. For example, owner name and address publication on AccessDane is guided by the county's privacy policy for the website. Some advanced mapping tools are not made available on the public portal because of the difficulties of using these tools across low bandwidth connections. Current content difference between portals is as follows:

[1] Citizens may opt out of owner name and address publication on the public portal of AccessDane. Approximately 97% of owner information contained in the real property database is published and available.

[2] The address update module is available to municipal staff responsible for submitting address information to the county.

[3] The Public portal does not allow owner name search or display of owner information (managed via integration with parcel information search module); departments will guide availability of data layers across the Internet, extranet and county intranet portals.
